**WHEREAS**, we pause today to recognize and honor the 500 immigrants from the city of Buscate, Italy (Lombardia, province Di Milano) who arrived in America during the great migration of 1880-1920 and settled in St. Louis City and the surrounding area; and

**WHEREAS**, in honor of their courageous journey in search of a better life facing many barriers such as language, culture, employment and housing; and

**WHEREAS**, rising above these obstacles and through hard work and strong family and cultural values, they are making an indelible mark on our landscape creating a stronger St. Louis.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to recognize the 500 immigrants from the city of Buscate, Italy (Lombardia, province Di Milano) who arrived in America during the great migration of 1880-1920 and settled in St. Louis City and the surrounding area and we direct the Clerk of this Board to spread a copy of this Resolution across the minutes of these proceedings and to further prepare a commemorative copy to the end that it may be presented to our honoree at a time and place deemed appropriate by the Sponsor.
