

**ORDINANCE #65488**  
**Board Bill No. 343**

An ordinance pertaining to health care services, authorizing the Health Commissioner of the City of St. Louis to immunize the general public against certain diseases, providing for the administration and delivery of said inoculations; authorizing and directing the Comptroller to establish a special purpose account where said funds from said immunizations shall be placed and used only for the purchase of more vaccine, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The Health Commissioner is hereby authorized to provide vaccinations for hepatitis A, hepatitis B, varicella (chicken pox), MMR (measles, mumps, rubella), TD (tetanus, diphtheria), Influenza, Pneumococcal, and Polio to the general public. The Department of Health and Hospitals shall establish rules and regulations and reasonable fees for the costs of administration and delivery of said inoculations.

SECTION TWO. The Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to establish a special purpose account where funds from said immunizations shall be placed and said funds shall only be used for the purchasing, maintenance and delivery of said immunizations.

SECTION THREE.. Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an immediate measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
