

ORDINANCE #68531
Board Bill No. 226
Floor Substitute

An ordinance for the repainting of all existing painted lines and/or markings following the completion of all public street construction or resurfacing; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Following the construction or resurfacing of any public street, all formerly existing painted lines or markings, including designated bicycle lanes, shall be clearly repainted by the St. Louis City Street Department, upon completion in accordance with the most current applicable Federal and State guidelines established in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) Bicycle Design Guide and Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). Notwithstanding major construction which makes repainting not possible.

SECTION TWO. Emergency Clause.

This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor.
