

St. Louis City Ordinance 62422

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [91] 226

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN MARIT CLARK

An Ordinance amending Ordinance 61289 by adding one new section authorizing the Excise Commissioner to issue a microbrewery license and establishing the fee for such license.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Ordinance 61289 is hereby amended by adding one new section which reads in words and figures as follows:

Section 14.07.060 Microbrewery License

(A) A microbrewery license shall authorize the licensee to manufacture beer and malt liquor in quantities not to exceed twenty- five hundred barrels per annum. The fee for such license shall be two-hundred-fifty dollars annually.

(B) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Ordinance or Title to the contrary, the holder of a microbrewery license may apply for a drink license and the Excise Commissioner may authorize issuance of, and the License Collector may issue, a drink license to the holder of the microbrewery license. A drink license may only be issued to a holder of a microbrewery license for the same premises for which the microbrewery license is issued. The provisions of chapter 14.08 of Ordinance 61289 shall apply to applications for issuance, issuance, renewal and protest of retail liquor licenses for premises licensed as a microbrewery.

SECTION TWO. **Emergency Clause.** This being an ordinance for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
