

# *St. Louis City Ordinance 62741*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

An ordinance permitting city court judges to order persons convicted of alcohol or drug related traffic offenses to reimburse the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department for its costs associated with the defendant's arrest.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Pursuant to Section 577.048 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, city court judges may order any person convicted of any alcohol or drug related traffic offense to reimburse the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department the costs associated with the arrest of said person. Such costs shall include the reasonable cost of making the arrest, including the cost of any chemical test made pursuant to Chapter 577 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, to determine the alcohol or drug content of the person's blood, and the costs of processing, charging, booking and holding such person in custody. A record of all such assessments and resulting collections shall be maintained by the Clerk of the City Courts and transmitted monthly to the Budget Division of the City of St. Louis. All monies collected pursuant to this legislation shall be maintained on the books of the City in a separate account established by the Comptroller. The St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department may establish a schedule of such costs; however, the court may order the costs reduced if it determines that the costs are excessive.
