

St. Louis City Ordinance 62926

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [93] 12

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN Paul M. Beckerle

An ordinance prohibiting truck traffic on certain streets and alleys; repealing Section 834.010 of Section One of Ordinance 57831, approved April 19, 1979, which is presently codified as Section 17.30.010 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis; enacting in lieu thereof a new Section 17.30.010 dealing with the same subject matter, but excepting certain trucks from said truck traffic prohibition; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Section 834.010 of Section One of Ordinance 57831, approved April 19, 1979, which is presently codified as Section 17.30.010 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis, is hereby repealed; and hereby enacted in lieu thereof is a new Section 17.30.010, which shall read as follows:

17.30.010. Truck traffic prohibited - Exceptions.

A. All truck traffic, except as herein provided, is prohibited except while loading, unloading or servicing on those streets and alleys set forth in the schedule thereof on file in the Office of the Register and the Traffic and Transportation Administrator which schedule is available for examination. Signs shall be erected designating the provisions of this section.

B. The prohibition contained herein shall not apply to non-commercial pick-up trucks as defined in Section 17.30.025.

C. This section shall not be construed as a prohibition against any truck which is traveling directly to a destination for loading, unloading or servicing, if there is no alternative route to said destination on streets and alleys where truck traffic is not prohibited.

SECTION TWO. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. This Ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare, shall be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Article IV, Section 20, of the Charter of the City of St. Louis, and as such shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the Mayor.
