

*St. Louis City Ordinance 63121*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [93] 225

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN ROBERT RUGGERI , FRANCIS SLAY

An ordinance expanding the 23rd and 24th Ward Housing Conservation Districts to include the portion of the Ellendale neighborhood not previously designated a Housing Conservation District, said area being bound by Hampton Avenue (viaduct), Manchester Avenue, Interstate 44, Frisco Railroad Tracks, Arsenal Street, Emilie Street, and the St. Louis City Limits; and containing an effective date.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance Nos. 61178, 61180, 61845, and 62335 the Board of Aldermen designated portions of the 23rd and 24th Wards as Housing Conservation Districts; and

WHEREAS, currently only a portion of the Ellendale neighborhood is in a Designated Housing Conservation District.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The 23rd and 24th Ward Housing Conservation Districts shall be expanded to include the area within the following boundaries:

Beginning at the point of the intersection of Manchester Avenue and Hampton Avenue (viaduct), thence generally in a clockwise direction along the center lines of the following streets, railroad tracks and St. Louis City Limits: Hampton Avenue (viaduct), Interstate 44, Southwest Avenue, Frisco Railroad Tracks, Arsenal Street, Emilie Street, St. Louis City Limits, Manchester Avenue, to the point of the beginning; said area being located in parts of Ward 23, and Ward 24 and in no other wards.

SECTION TWO: Effective Date: This ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 1994 after approval by the Mayor.
