An Ordinance pertaining to immunizations against blood borne pathogens for high risk public employees, providing for the immunization against Hepatitis B of said employees and containing an effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The Department of Health and Hospitals for the City of St. Louis shall offer immunization against Hepatitis B for all law enforcement officers, firefighters, paramedics, nurses, emergency medical personnel and technicians, ambulance attendants, correctional officers, building and health inspectors, and other at risk employees of the City of St. Louis as determined by the Health Commissioner.

SECTION TWO. The Health Commissioner shall issue rules and regulations for the implementation of this ordinance.

SECTION THREE. This ordinance shall have an effective date of November 1, 1996.
