

St. Louis City Ordinance 63912

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN STEPHEN CONWAY , PHYLLIS YOUNG ,

An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Health and Hospitals, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into a contract amendment with the State of Missouri for cardiovascular/diabetes disease control services, referred to as Targeted Health Initiative, and authorizing the Director of Health and Hospitals, on behalf of the City, and upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment to expend the funds by entering contracts or otherwise for cardiovascular/diabetes disease services, and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, the City has entered into a contract with the State for the purpose of providing cardiovascular/diabetes control services, said contract being Comptroller's Office document #24068.

WHEREAS, the State has provided additional funding in the amount of \$123,000.00 to the City for cardiovascular/diabetes control services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS
FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The Director of Health and Hospitals is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a contract amendment with the Missouri Department of Health for a contract to fund a cardiovascular/diabetes control program. Said amendment shall substantially be in this Ordinance and words and figures as the contract amendment, which is made part of this ordinance and is on file in the Register's Office.

SECTION TWO. The Director of Health and Hospitals is hereby authorized and directed, upon the approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend the funds received pursuant to the amendment, by contract or otherwise, in a manner and purpose that is consistent with the provisions of said Amendment.

SECTION THREE. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of

the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
