

# St. Louis City Ordinance 64075

## FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [97] 70

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JOSEPH RODDY

An ordinance establishing a two way stop site for all traffic approaching from either direction on Oakland Avenue at a point 500 feet west of Lawn Place, in City Block 3995, for purposes of regulating traffic and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. There is hereby established a two way stop site on Oakland Avenue at a point 500 feet west of Lawn Place in City Block 3995. The director of streets is hereby authorized and directed to install stop signs at said location to regulate traffic on Oakland Avenue at all times.

SECTION TWO. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
