

St. Louis City Ordinance 64090

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [97] 66

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN STEPHEN GREGALI

An ordinance repealing Ordinance 52450, approved on March 12, 1964, and enacting in lieu thereof a new ordinance pertaining to the same subject matter establishing a three way stop site for all traffic approaching the interesection of Morganford Road and Neosho Street and containing an emergency clause.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Ordinance 52450, approved on March 12, 1964, is hereby repealed.

SECTION TWO. There is hereby established a three way stop site at the intersection of Morganford Road and Neosho Street. The director of streets is hereby authorized and directed to install stop signs at said location to regulate traffic approaching this intersection.

SECTION THREE. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
