FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [97] 264

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JOSEPH RODDY

An ordinance establishing a two way stop site for all north-south traffic traveling on Boyle Avenue approaching the intersection of Boyle Avenue and Norfolk Avenue thereby establishing a three way stop site at said intersection; containing an emergency clause.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. There is hereby established a two way stop site for all north-south traffic traveling on Boyle Avenue approaching the intersection of Boyle Avenue and Norfolk Avenue thereby establishing a three way stop site at said intersection.. The director of streets is hereby authorized and directed to install stop signs at said location to regulate traffic approaching this intersection.

SECTION THREE. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
