

St. Louis City Ordinance 65070

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE
BOARD BILL NO. 184 [00]

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN IRVING C. CLAY, JR.

An ordinance to amend Ordinance 64455 approved August 12, 1998 relating to cooperative agreements between the Employees Retirement System of the City of St. Louis and certain other retirement systems by repealing Section One thereof and enacting a new section relating to the same subject matter and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Section One of Ordinance 64455 approved August 12, 1998 is hereby repealed and the following new Section One is enacted in lieu thereof to read as follows:

"The Secretary of the Board of Trustees for the Employees Retirement System of the City of St. Louis, with the approval of the Board of Trustees, is authorized to enter into cooperative agreements to transfer creditable service between the Employees Retirement System plan and any other retirement plan established by the State of Missouri or any political subdivision or instrumentality of the state when a member who has been employed in a position covered by one plan is employed in a position covered by another plan. The transfer of creditable service shall be in accordance with the provisions of Section 105.691 of the Missouri Revised Statutes (1994) as amended, or Section 104.1090 of the Missouri Revised Statutes (1994) as amended, or as the same may from time to time be amended."

SECTION TWO. This being an Ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, or safety, it is hereby declared an emergency measure as designed in Article IV, Section 20 of the City Charter and shall become effective immediately upon its approval by the Mayor of the City of St. Louis.
