

St. Louis City Ordinance 65149

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JAMES F.SHREWSBURY

An Ordinance recommended and approved by the Airport Commission, Board of Public Service, and the Board of Estimate and Apportionment authorizing a "Second Amendment" to Section One of the Master Plan Expansion Program Ordinance 64279 approved March 9, 1998, as amended by Ordinance 64598 approved February 18, 1999, adding certain real property or additional tracts of land more fully described in Section One of this Ordinance to the geographical boundaries described in the Master Plan Expansion Program Ordinance 64279 as amended; authorizing a Third Supplemental Appropriation in the amount of the proceeds from "The City of St. Louis, Missouri Airport Revenue Bonds, Series 2000A (Airport Development Program)" (the "Series 2000A Bonds") deposited by the City and/or Trustee into the Series 2000A Airport Construction Account of the Construction Fund to pay the cost of the 2000A Project as defined and provided for in Ordinance 65087 approved November 22, 2000 (the "Series 2000A Bond Ordinance") or to reimburse the City in connection with the amounts expended therefore from the Construction Account in the Construction Fund established pursuant to the Series 2000A Bond Ordinance into the Master Plan Expansion Program Ordinance 64279 as amended, in order to continue the W-1W Expansion Program and the payment or reimbursement of eligible costs for work and services authorized therein; authorizing and directing the Comptroller or Treasurer of the City, as necessary, to make such applications or certifications and provide such data to the Trustee of the Series 2000A Bonds authorized under the Series 2000A Bond Ordinance 65087, and to take whatever action necessary in order to provide for the payment or reimbursement of eligible costs authorized therein; conditioning the appropriation and the expenditure of funds authorized herein on the issuance of the Series 2000A Bonds; and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, the Master Plan Expansion Program Ordinance 64279 approved March 9, 1998, authorized and established a multi-year public work and improvement program (the "W-1W Expansion Program") at

Lambert-St. Louis International Airport (the "Airport") providing for the development, improvement, construction, rehabilitation, reconfiguration and expansion of the Airport as more fully described therein at a total estimated cost of Two Billion Six Hundred Million Dollars (\$2,600,000,000), made an initial appropriation of Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000) from the Airport Development Fund, and contained a severability clause and an emergency clause;

WHEREAS, Ordinance 64598 approved February 18, 1999 amended Section Eleven of the Master Plan Expansion Program Ordinance 64279 approved March 9, 1998, by inserting language authorizing the deposit of certain program funds into Ordinance 64279 to reimburse in part the costs of the W-1W Expansion Program, authorized a First Supplemental Appropriation in the amount of Thirteen Million Dollars (\$13,000,000) from the Airport Development Fund, and contained an emergency clause;

WHEREAS, Ordinance 64877 approved February 22, 2000, authorized a Second Supplemental Appropriation in the amount of the proceeds from "The City of St. Louis, Missouri Letter of Intent Double Barrel Revenue Bonds, Series 2000 (Lambert-St. Louis International Airport Project)" (the "Series 2000 Bonds") deposited by the Trustee in the Project Account in the Project Fund to pay the cost of the Project as defined and provided for in Ordinance 64810 approved December 21, 1999 (the "Series 2000 Bond Ordinance"), from the Project Account in the Project Fund established pursuant to the Series 2000 Bond Ordinance 64810, into the Master Plan Expansion Program Ordinance 64279 as amended, said Second Supplemental Appropriation expressly conditioned on the issuance of the Series 2000 Bonds, and containing an emergency clause;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Section One of the Master Plan Expansion Program Ordinance 64279 as amended adding certain real property or tracts of land more fully described in Section One of this Ordinance to the geographical boundaries described in the Master Plan Expansion Program Ordinance 64279 as previously amended;

WHEREAS, it is also necessary to authorize a Third Supplemental Appropriation in the amount of the proceeds from "The City of St. Louis, Missouri Airport Revenue Bonds, Series 2000A (Airport Development Program)" (the "Series 2000A Bonds") deposited by the City and/or Trustee into the Series 2000A Airport Construction Account of the Construction Fund to pay the cost of the 2000A Project as defined

and provided for in Ordinance 65087 approved November 22, 2000 (the "Series 2000A Bond Ordinance") or to reimburse the City in connection with the amounts expended therefore from the Construction Account in the Construction Fund established pursuant to the Series 2000A Bond Ordinance into the Master Plan Expansion Program Ordinance 64279 as amended, in order to continue the W-1W Expansion Program and the payment or reimbursement of eligible costs for work and services authorized therein; and

WHEREAS, the appropriation and expenditure of funds authorized herein are expressly conditioned on the issuance of the Series 2000A Bonds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Section One of the Master Plan Expansion Program Ordinance 64279 approved March 9, 1998, as amended by Ordinance 64598 approved February 18, 1999, is hereby amended by adding the following words and figures (including an addition exhibit titled "Exhibit A-1" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein) after the words "real property located within the geographical boundaries including approximately 3,472 acres as describe in "Exhibit A":

"and certain other real property or tracts of land or parcels as described in "Exhibit A-1" which are".

SECTION TWO. There is hereby authorized a Third Supplemental Appropriation in the amount of the proceed from "The City of St. Louis, Missouri, Airport Revenue Bonds, Series 2000A (Airport Development Program)" (the "Series 2000A Bonds") deposited by the City of St. Louis (the "City") and/or Trustee into the Series 2000A Airport Construction Account of the Construction Fund to pay the costs of the 2000A Project as defined and provided for in Ordinance 65087 approved November 22, 2000 (the "Series 2000A Bond Ordinance") or to reimburse the City in connection with the amounts expended therefore, from the Construction Account in the Construction Fund established pursuant to the Series 2000A Bond Ordinance into the Master Plan Expansion Program Ordinance 64279 as amended, in order to continue the W-1W Expansion Program and the payment or reimbursement of eligible costs for work and services authorized therein.

SECTION THREE. The Comptroller or Treasurer of the City of St. Louis, as necessary, are hereby authorized and directed to make such applications or certifications and provide such data to the Trustee of the Series 2000A Bonds authorized under the Series 2000A Bond Ordinance 65087, and to take whatever action necessary in order to provide for the payment or reimbursement of eligible costs authorized therein.

SECTION FOUR. The appropriation and expenditure of funds authorized herein are hereby expressly conditioned on the issuance of the Series 2000A Bonds.

SECTION FIVE. This being an Ordinance providing for a public works and improvement program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article IV, Section 20, of the City's Charter and shall become effective immediately upon approval by the Mayor of the City.
