

1 **BOARD BILL #201 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN GREGORY CARTER**

2 An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety, on behalf
3 of the Mayor and the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement with
4 the U. S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, to fund the 2011 Justice
5 Assistance Grant Program, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment,
6 and to expend funds by entering into contracts or otherwise for grant purposes and
7 containing an emergency clause.

8 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

9 **SECTION ONE.** The Mayor and the Director of Public Safety, are hereby
10 authorized and directed, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a
11 Grant Agreement with U. S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, to fund
12 the 2011 Justice Assistance Program.

13 **SECTION TWO.** The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized and
14 directed, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend the
15 funds, which are hereby appropriated for said purpose, by entering into contracts or
16 otherwise received pursuant to the 2011 Grant Agreement, totaling \$737,581.00, in a
17 manner that is consistent with the provisions of said Agreement, a copy of which is
18 attached hereto and shall become part of the ordinance.

19 **SECTION 3.** Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate
20 preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an immediate
21 measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the
22 City of St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon
23 its passage and approval by the Mayor.
