

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 202 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN LYDA**
2 **KREWSON, ALDERMAN FRANK WILLIAMSON**

4 An ordinance submitting to the qualified voters residing in the DeBaliviere Place Special
5 Business District Special Business District as designated in Ordinance
6 No. _____, approved DATE (Board Bill No. ____) a proposal to renew and
7 continue the levy a tax on the real property located in said district; submitting said
8 proposal to the voters of said district at an Election on April 7, 2015; and containing an
9 emergency clause.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

11 SECTION ONE. The following proposition is hereby submitted to the qualified voters
12 residing in the DeBaliviere Place Special Business District Special Business District, as
13 designated in Ordinance No. _____, approved DATE, (Board Bill No. ____) and shall be
14 voted upon at the election to be held as hereinafter provided. The proposition shall read
15 substantially in words and figures as follows:

16 Shall a tax of \$.85 per \$100.00 valuation be imposed for the tax years 2015, 2016,
17 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 on all real property located in the
18 DeBaliviere Place Special Business District as defined in Ordinance No. _____,
19 approved DATE, (Board Bill No. ____) for the purposes as set forth in said Ordinance?

20 SECTION TWO. The foregoing proposition shall be submitted to qualified voters
21 residing in the DeBaliviere Place Special Business District at a special election in said
22 District to be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2015. If the proposition shall receive in its favor
23 the votes of the majority of the qualified voters voting at said election for or against said
24 proposition, the tax as set forth within said proposition shall be authorized and adopted

1 and become part of the laws of the City of St. Louis from the date of said election. The
2 qualified voters may, at such election, vote a ballot substantially in the following form:

4 Shall a tax of \$.85 per \$100.00 valuation be imposed for the tax years 2015, 2016, 2017,
5 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 on all real property located in the
6 DeBaliviere Place Special Business District as defined in Ordinance No. _____,
7 approved DATE, (Board Bill No. __) for the purposes as set forth in said Ordinance?

10 SECTION THREE. Notice of the election on such proposition shall be published and said
11 election shall be conducted in the manner provided by law.

12 SECTION FOUR. Immediately upon the passage and approval of this Ordinance, the
13 City Register shall certify a copy thereof to the Board of Election Commissioners for the
14 City of St. Louis for action and proceedings by said Board in accordance herewith and as
15 required by law.

16 SECTION FIVE. This being an ordinance calling and providing for an election and vote
17 by the people and fixing a tax rate, it is declared to be an emergency measure as defined
18 by Article IV, Sections 19 and 20 of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and shall take
19 effect and be in force from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
