7 submit all necessary applications and to enter into agreements with the Missouri Foundation for
8 Health or any other agency (Grant # 11-0226-HAC) for the “St. Louis Healthy Corner Store
9 Project;” and with the Missouri Foundation for Health or any other agency (Grant # 11-0442-
10 SOF-11) for the “Community Health Assessment/Improvement Plan;” and authorizing the
11 Mayor, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend any funds
12 received by said grants to fulfill the obligations of the grants, and containing an emergency
13 clause.

15 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

17 **SECTION ONE:** The Mayor, on the behalf of the City of St. Louis, is hereby authorized and
18 directed to submit all necessary applications and to enter into any agreements with the Missouri
19 Foundation for Health or any other agency (Grant # 11-0226-HAC) for the “St. Louis Healthy
20 Corner Store Project;” and with the Missouri Foundation for Health or any other agency (Grant #
21 11-0442-SOF-11) for the “Community Health Assessment/Improvement Plan;” and authorizing
22 the Mayor, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend any funds
23 received by said grant to fulfill the obligations of the grant.

25 **SECTION TWO:** Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public
26 peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of
