

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 240 INTRODUCED BY ALD. CHARLES QUINCY TROUPE**

2 An ordinance pertaining to commercial trucks, truck-tractors, tractors, and
3 commercial trailer traffic; prohibiting such traffic on Union Boulevard from the north
4 boundary of Interstate Highway 70 to south boundary of West Florissant Avenue,
5 exempting from said prohibition emergency vehicles, including privately owned tow
6 trucks when providing emergency service to non-commercial vehicles, and containing an
7 emergency clause.

8 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

9 **Section One:** No person shall drive, tow, or move any commercial truck, truck-
10 tractor, tractor, or commercial trailer on Union Boulevard from the north boundary of
11 Interstate Highway 70 to south boundary of West Florissant Avenue.

12 **Section Two:** The provisions of Section One of this ordinance shall not apply
13 to emergency vehicles, including privately owned tow trucks when providing emergency
14 service to non-commercial vehicles.

15 **Section Three:** This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace,
16 health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning
17 of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore
18 shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor.
