

1 An Ordinance recommended by, and authorizing and directing, the Board of Public
2 Service to let contracts, purchase materials, equipment and supplies, employ labor, hire
3 consultants, pay fees, salaries and wages, and do all things necessary to provide for
4 improvements to the Chain of Rocks and Howard Bend Water Treatment Plants of the City of St.
5 Louis Water Division; to appropriate and pay the estimated cost of Three Million Dollars
6 (\$3,000,000.00) from the Water Works Contingent Account, pursuant to Section Five Hundred
7 Two (502) of Ordinance Number 63135, approved March 29, 1994; containing sections for
8 description of the work, approval of plans and specifications, work and material guarantees,
9 estimated expenditures, allocation and reversion authorizations, reimbursement authorization,
10 applicable state and federal wage rate requirements, equal opportunity provisions, the Mayor’s
11 Executive Orders, contract advertising statutes, and a public work emergency clause.

12 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

13 **SECTION ONE.** The Board of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to let
14 contracts, purchase materials, equipment and supplies, employ labor, hire consultants, pay fees,
15 salaries and wages, and otherwise provide for improvements to the Chain of Rocks and Howard
16 Bend Water Treatment Plants of the City of St. Louis Water Division, in accordance with the
17 plans and specifications approved and adopted by the Board of Public Service.

18 **SECTION TWO.** The work provided herein shall be carried out in accordance with
19 detailed plans and specifications to be adopted and approved by the Board of Public Service
20 before bids are advertised therefore.

21 **SECTION THREE.** Any contract, or contracts, shall provide that the contractor, or
22 contractors, doing said work shall guarantee and keep in good repair all of the work and

1 materials used in connection therewith for a term of at least one (1) year, commencing on the
2 date of acceptance of the work by the City.

3 **SECTION FOUR.** The sum of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) is hereby
4 appropriated and allocated to pay the estimated cost of the work authorized herein from the
5 Water Works Contingent Account, pursuant to Section Five Hundred Two (502) of Ordinance
6 Number 63135, approved March 29, 1994. All funds remaining in this appropriation and
7 allocation, after the final time of acceptance of the work, shall revert to the same source from
8 which they were appropriated and allocated, after the expiration of any guarantee period.

9 **SECTION FIVE.** All construction contracts let under authority of this ordinance shall
10 provide that no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages be paid in the City of St. Louis, as
11 determined by the Federal Davis-Bacon Act and the Department of Labor and Industrial
12 Relations of the State of Missouri; said prevailing wage shall be paid for each craft or type of
13 worker needed in the actual construction work of the job herein authorized, as well as the general
14 prevailing rate of pay for legal holidays and overtime work. All labor performed under this
15 contract shall be subject to the provisions of Section 290.210 to 290.340 inclusive, of the
16 Revised Statutes of Missouri, 1986, as amended, and the charter and Code of the City of St.
17 Louis.

18 **SECTION SIX.** The Comptroller of the City of St. Louis shall be hereby directed to
19 draw warrants from time to time on the Treasurer of said City for the several payments and costs
20 specified in Section One hereof.

21 **SECTION SEVEN.** All specifications approved by the Board of Public Service and
22 contracts let under the authority of this ordinance shall provide for compliance with all

1 ordinances and Mayor's Executive Orders on equal opportunity and on selection of experts and
2 consultants except when superseded or otherwise prohibited by Federal or State Regulations.

3 **SECTION EIGHT.** All advertisements for bids, pursuant to this Ordinance, shall be
4 subject to Section 8.250 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, 1986, as amended.

5 **SECTION NINE.** Emergency Clause.

6 This being an Ordinance providing for public work and improvements, and the passage thereof
7 being deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, an
8 emergency is hereby declared to exist within the meaning of Section 20 of Article IV of the
9 Charter of the City of St. Louis and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its
10 passage and approval by the Mayor.
