

**BOARD BILL NO. 69 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN KACIE STARR TRIPLETT**

1 An ordinance authorizing the City of St. Louis (hereinafter, “City”), by and through its  
2 Board of Public Service, to enter into an Agreement with the Missouri Highways and  
3 Transportation Commission (hereinafter, “Commission”) for the Commission to remove  
4 and replace the Jefferson Avenue Bridge Over Interstate 64 and associated highway  
5 ramps (hereinafter, “Project”) without cost to the City.

6 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

7 **SECTION ONE.** The City of Saint Louis, by and through its Board of Public Service, is  
8 hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with the Commission to  
9 remove and replace the Jefferson Avenue Bridge Over Interstate 64 and associated  
10 highway ramps without cost to the City in substantially the form attached hereto and  
11 incorporated by reference herein as Exhibit 1.

12 **SECTION TWO.** The Commission and the City shall cooperate to temporarily close all  
13 streets, or parts thereof, which may be necessary to permit the construction of the project  
14 in accordance with the detailed plans approved by the Federal Highway Administration  
15 (hereinafter, “FHWA”).

16 **SECTION THREE.** The Commission and the City shall cooperate to secure the  
17 temporary or permanent removal, relocation, or adjustment of public utilities or private  
18 lines, poles, wires, conduits, and pipes located on the right-of-way of existing public  
19 ways as necessary for construction of the project in accordance with the detailed plans  
20 approved by FHWA.

21 **SECTION FOUR.** The Commission shall install, operate, and maintain lighting, traffic  
22 control devices, drainage facilities, and other applicable work and facilities in accordance

1 with the detailed plans approved by FHWA.

2 **SECTION FIVE.** Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate  
3 preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency  
4 within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of  
5 St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its  
6 passage and approval by the Mayor.
