

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 75 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN ANTONIO D. FRENCH**

3 An ordinance pertaining to dog training in public parks; regulating dog training  
4 activities, requiring a permit for the activity and containing an emergency clause.

5 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

6 **SECTION ONE.** No dog training activity in a St. Louis Public Park shall not occur  
7 within one thousand (1000) feet of any playground, jogging trail, athletic fields,  
8 swimming pools and/or basketball courts. All prior existing ordinances shall remain in  
9 full force and effect.

10 **SECTION TWO.** Any person wishing to train dogs in a public park is required to obtain  
11 a valid permit from the city for the conduct of obedience or other types of training of  
12 dogs in or upon any public place.

13 **SECTION THREE.** Emergency clause.

14 This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is  
15 hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of  
16 Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore shall become effective  
17 immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor.
