

BOARD BILL NO. 89 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN TERRY KENNEDY

1 An Ordinance recommended and approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment
2 authorizing and directing the Director of Airports and the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis (the
3 “City”) to enter into and execute on behalf of the City the License Agreement for the K-Lot Facility
4 (License No. DTFACE-10-J-00001) (the "License Agreement"), between the City and the United
5 States of America, Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration (the “FAA”),
6 granting the City the right to conduct and stage contractors, store equipment and materials, and
7 provide overflow parking on certain property more fully described in Section 1 of the License
8 Agreement, subject to and in accordance with the terms, covenants, and conditions of the License
9 Agreement, which was approved by the Airport Commission and is attached hereto as
10 **ATTACHMENT “1”** and made a part hereof; containing a severability clause; and containing an
11 emergency clause.

12 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

13 **SECTION O/-NE.** The Director of Airports and the Comptroller for the City of St. Louis
14 (the "City") are hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute on behalf of the City the
15 License Agreement for the K-Lot Facility (License No. DTFACE-10-J-00001) (the "License
16 Agreement"), between the City and the United States of America, Department of Transportation,
17 Federal Aviation Administration (the “FAA”), granting the City the right to conduct and stage
18 contractors, store equipment and materials, and provide overflow parking on certain property more
19 fully described in Section 1 of the License Agreement, subject to and in accordance with the terms,
20 covenants, and conditions of the License Agreement, which was approved by the Airport
21 Commission and is to read in words and figures substantially as set out in **ATTACHMENT “1”**,

1 which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2 **SECTION TWO.** The sections, conditions, or provisions of this Ordinance or portions
3 thereof shall be severable. If any section, condition, or provision of this Ordinance or portion thereof
4 is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining
5 sections, conditions, or provisions of this Ordinance.

6 **SECTION THREE.** This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health,
7 or safety, it is hereby declared an emergency measure as defined in Article IV, Section 20, of the
8 City's Charter and shall become effective immediately upon its approval by the Mayor of the City.
