



1 **WHEREAS**, the amount of indebtedness hereinafter proposed to be incurred, when added  
2 to the outstanding and authorized indebtedness of said City, will not exceed any limit of  
3 indebtedness established by the Constitution or Statutes of the State of Missouri or by the  
4 Charter of the City of St. Louis.

5 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

6 **SECTION ONE.** That a special bond election shall be held, and the same is hereby called  
7 and ordered to be held in the City of St. Louis, Missouri on the **4<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2014**,  
8 at which there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of said City, the propositions, as  
9 hereinafter set forth in Section Three of this ordinance.

10 **SECTION TWO.** That the polling places in the various wards and precincts in the City of  
11 St. Louis whereat the said propositions shall be submitted to the qualified electors of said  
12 City shall be those polling places established or to be established by the Board of Election  
13 Commissioners for the City of St. Louis, as provided by law.

14 **SECTION THREE.** The notice of the submission of the said proposition at the said special  
15 bond election shall be given jointly by the said Board of Election Commissioners and by the  
16 City Register of the City of St. Louis by publication in the City Journal, the St. Louis Post-  
17 Dispatch, and at least one other weekly newspaper serving citizens of the City of St. Louis,  
18 once each week for three (3) consecutive weeks, the first publication in each instance to be  
19 at least twenty-one-days before, and the last publication within two (2) weeks before the  
20 said election, which said notice shall be in substantially the following form:

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a bond election will be held in the City of St. Louis, Missouri on Tuesday, the **4<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2014**, commencing at six o'clock in the morning, Central Daylight Time, and closing at seven o'clock in the evening, Central Daylight Time, on said date.

The polling places in the various wards and precincts of the City of St. Louis whereat the said propositions shall be submitted to the qualified electors of said City shall be those polling places designated or to be designated by the Board of Election Commissioners of the City of St. Louis, Missouri, separate notice of which will be given by said Board.

Subject to such modifications as may be required by the use of an electronic voting system, the ballots to be used at said election shall be in substantially the following form, to-wit:

1 To vote in favor of the propositions submitted upon this ballot, place a cross (X) mark in the  
2 square opposite the word "YES"; and, to vote against the said proposition, place a cross (X)  
3 mark in the square opposite the word "NO".

4 PROPOSITION NO. 1

5 Shall the following be adopted:

6 Proposition to issue bonds of the City of St. Louis, Missouri in an amount  
7 not to exceed **One Hundred Ninety-Six Million Five Hundred Thousand**  
8 **Dollars (\$196,500,000)** for the purpose of funding a portion of the cost of  
9 acquiring certain real property for, and purchasing, replacing, improving, and  
10 maintaining the buildings, **vehicles**, and equipment of, the City, the St. Louis  
11 Police Department, Fire Department, **and** Emergency Medical Services, and  
12 other City departments and for maintaining the safety and security of the  
13 jails and improving public safety; for funding a portion of the costs of  
14 reconstructing, repairing and improving streets, bridges, **and sidewalks**; for  
15 funding a portion of the costs of infrastructure development and of  
16 demolition and abatement of various abandoned or condemned buildings  
17 owned by or under the control of the City of St. Louis or its related agencies;  
18 **for funding a portion of the costs of implementing complete streets**  
19 **initiatives; for funding a portion of the cost of city owned building**  
20 **stabilization and preservation; for funding a portion of the cost of St.**  
21 **Louis city resident home repair programs; for funding a portion of the**  
22 **cost of establishing a tool lending library for St. Louis City residents, for**  
23 **funding a portion of the costs of bike and pedestrian transportation**

1           **infrastructure; for funding ward capital improvements; for funding a**  
2           **portion of the cost of paying for economic development and job creation**  
3           **programs, and for paying incidental costs of such work and of issuing the**  
4           Bonds.

Proof of the publication of said notice shall be made by affidavits of the publishers of said newspapers, with a copy of such publication attached thereto, and such affidavits shall be filed with the City Register.

1 **SECTION FOUR.** That the Board of Election Commissioners for the City of St. Louis,  
2 Missouri shall provide the ballots, conduct the election, and certify the results of said bond  
3 election to the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis, Missouri, as required by law.

4 **SECTION FIVE.** That if the said propositions, respectively, be assented to by **two-thirds**  
5 **(2/3)** or more of the qualified electors voting thereon, bonds in the amount and for the  
6 purpose designated in said propositions may be issued.

7 **SECTION SIX.** That the proceeds of the sale or sales of any of the bonds which may be  
8 authorized by the requisite affirmative vote shall be used only for the purposes designated in  
9 the proposition with which the bonds are identified, **and shall be used substantially in**  
10 **accordance with Exhibit A attached hereto to this ordinance unless and to the extent**  
11 **otherwise agreed upon by both the Board of Estimate & Apportionment and the Ways**  
12 **& Means Committee of the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis** in accordance  
13 with the purposes designated in the proposition with which the bonds are identified.

14 **SECTION SEVEN.** That immediately upon the passage and approval of this ordinance, the  
15 Clerk of the Board of Aldermen shall certify a copy thereof to the Board of Election  
16 Commissioners for the City of St. Louis, Missouri for action and proceedings by said Board  
17 in accordance herewith and as required by law.

18 **SECTION EIGHT.** This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health  
19 and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections  
20 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance  
21 shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
